ForestWISE is a Collaborative Laboratory focused on forest and fire issues through the development of (co)research, innovation and knowledge transfer and technology activities. Our goal is to increase and improve sustainable forest management in Portugal, the competitiveness of the Portuguese forestry sector and to reduce negative consequences of large rural fires.

ForestWISE currently leads or participates in national and international large scale and impact projects in the forest and fire areas.

ForestWISE opens position for **two Project Technicians** in the scope of the rePLANT project - Grounding collaborative strategies for integrated management of forest and fire, with the codename POCI-01-0247-FEDER-046081 (Notice 14/SI/2019 - Business R&DT (Mobilising Programmes)), co-funded by Compete/Portugal 2020, through the Competitiveness and Innovation Operational Programme (POCI) and the Lisbon 2020 Operational Programme.

**Position:** Project Technician – two positions (forest management, forest operations and logistics, forestry equipment)

#### Summary description of the function:

Under the supervision of the ForestWISE's CTO and rePLANT's project coordination, the Project Technician will:

- Develop actions aimed at knowledge creation and technology transfer to companies and other agents, based on rePLANT's results, contributing to potentiate them;
- Develop data collection work in the field, through inventory techniques, surveys, company visits, among others;
- Support necessary actions in the project management and planned demonstration actions;
- Develop activity reports in the project context;
- Identify opportunities and develop all initiatives that may contribute to the implementation of the activities associated to the project;
- Promote and participate in ForestWISE's communication, dissemination and knowledge transfer initiatives, associated to the project, or others, that may be relevant to it;
- Represent ForestWISE when requested, in events and relevant initiatives to their work line and to ForestWISE in general.

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**Qualifications:**

Bachelor's degree (pre-Bologna) or Master's degree in Forestry Sciences or related areas.

**Required experience:**

- Proven professional experience in project management in forest management, particularly in one or more of the following areas: forest management, information and technology for forest management, forest operations and forestry equipment;
- Experience in organizing communication, dissemination, and knowledge transfer initiatives, especially for the forestry sector;
- Experience in working with public and private forestry sector entities and other forestry sector agents in Portugal;
- Experience in the participation and/or management of research and/or consultancy projects.

**Personal skills/ Soft Skills:**

- Organisational skills, self-motivation and a results-oriented work method;
- Easy to relate to different interlocutors;
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills and a taste for teamwork;
- Availability and flexibility of working hours;
- Driver's licence for passenger vehicles.

**Evaluation Criteria:**

- Interview with candidates with curricular evaluation equal to or greater than 15 points
- The final classification will be the weighted average of the curriculum evaluation, which will assume a weight of 60%, and the interview, which will represent 40%
- Selection of the candidate with the best final ranking
- The jury reserves the right to decide not to select any candidate if they agree that none of the candidates has the profile required.

**Conditions:**

The hired Project Technician will be entitled to an employment contract (6 months) with a fixed annual salary between TRU 13 and TRU 21 levels according to the curriculum vitae and the experience presented and proven.
