Position: Project Technician (forest management, forest operations and logistics, forestry equipment)

Summary description of the function:

Under the supervision of the ForestWISE's CTO and rePLANT's project coordination, the Project Technician will:

- Develop actions aimed at knowledge creation and technology transfer to companies and other agents, based on the results of rePLANT, contributing to increase its results;

Proven professional experience in project management in the area of forest management, particularly in one or more of the following areas: forest management, information and technology for forest management, forest operations and forestry equipment;

- Experience in the organisation of communication, dissemination and knowledge transfer initiatives, particularly for the forestry sector;
- Experience in working with public and private forestry sector entities and other forestry sector agents in Portugal;
- Experience in the participation and/or management of research and/or consultancy projects.
